# Speakers for 2024



**Dr. Joel R. Beeke** was converted at the age of 14, and has pastored for 45 years in three churches. Currently, he is chancellor and professor of homiletics and systematic and practical theology at Puritan Reformed Theological Seminary (since 1994), a pastor of the Heritage Reformed Congregation in Grand Rapids, Michigan (since 1986), editor of Puritan Reformed Journal and Banner of Sovereign Grace Truth, board chairman of Reformation Heritage Books, president of Inheritance Publishers, and vice-president of the Dutch Reformed Translation Society. He has written and co-authored 125 hundred books (most recently, Reformed Systematic Theology, Reformed Preaching: Preaching God's Word from the Heart of the Preacher to the Heart of His People, A Puritan Theology: Doctrine for Life; Knowing and Growing in Assurance; and Debated Issues in Sovereign Predestination), edited another 125 books, and contributed 2,500 articles to Reformed books, journals, periodicals, and encyclopedias. His PhD is in Reformation and Post-Reformation theology from Westminster Theological Seminary (Philadelphia) on assurance of faith. He is frequently called upon to lecture at seminaries and to speak at Reformed conferences around the world in several dozen countries. He and his wife Mary have been blessed with three children and ten grandchildren.



**Mary Beeke** is married to Joel Beeke. They have three grown children and ten grandchildren. She is the author of "The Law of Kindness" and "Teach Them to Work." She has worked as a nurse and a teacher. She travels with Joel and speaks occasionally at conferences.

# Mission Statement:

The motive of the conference is to glorify God, honor His gospel, and strengthen His churches by providing encouragement to Baptists in historical, Biblical, theological, practical, and ecumenical studies.

The purpose is to be a balanced conference in respect to doctrine and devotion expressed in the Doctrines of Grace and their experimental application to the local church, particularly in the areas of worship and witness.
